

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
03-16-2026

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday March 16th, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: David Proctor, Carolyn Smith, Joseph Appleby, Rick Coleman, Larry Bishop. and City Clerk Nicholas New, Police Chief Richard Bickerstaff, and Court Clerk Jodie McKinney. City Supervisor Rusty Taylor was absent.

Mayor Roy Adamson called the meeting to order. Mayor then asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous Council meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member Proctor and seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was made by Council Member Appleby and seconded by Council Member Coleman. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda was to approve the yearly contract with the Clay County Economic Development Council. The contract is \$1,000 per month. Mayor Adamson mentions that the CCEDC and director Chance Jones have been a big help to the City. A motion was made by Councilmember Proctor and seconded by Councilmember Smith to approve this contract. The vote was unanimous.

Next on the agenda was to vote to take Good Friday, April 3rd, 2026 as a holiday for City employees. A motion was made by Councilmember Smith and seconded by Councilmember Appleby to approve this holiday. The vote was unanimous.

Last on the agenda was to approve a park reservation for Mamie Turman, this event would be a family reunion at pavilion 2 on April 11th. A motion was made by Councilmember Proctor and seconded by Councilmember Bishop to approve this reservation. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor Adamson mentioned that the City is working hard on our America250 celebration. Councilmember Smith commends the librarian, Sara, on her hard work and says that the library has a lot of visitors coming in. Councilmember Proctor mentions that the Shriners Club had their check presentation last week, and raised a total of \$51,000 last year, bringing the all time total to over \$1,000,000.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Bishop and seconded by Council Member Coleman. The vote was unanimous. The meeting ended at 5:08 p.m.
