

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**03-02-2026**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: David Proctor, Carolyn Smith, Joseph Appleby, Rick Coleman, Larry Bishop, and City Clerk Nicholas New, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, Police Chief Richard Bickerstaff, and Court Clerk Jodie McKinney.

Mayor Roy Adamson called the meeting to order. Mayor then asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous Council meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member Proctor and seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was made by Council Member Appleby and seconded by Council Member Coleman. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda was to hire Matt Crenshaw as an assistant director for the Lineville baseball/softball program. This would be a contract position at a payrate of \$1,500/year. A motion was made by Councilmember Bishop and seconded by Councilmember Proctor to approve this hire. The vote was unanimous.

City Clerk New mentioned that the City completed their application for the Rebuild Alabama Grant Act. City Supervisor Taylor mentioned that we have 320 kids signed up to play baseball/softball with 28 teams. Taylor says practice starts this week and games will start April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Taylor also thanks the Council for hiring Matt to help him and he gives an update on the upcoming events happening on the fields. Councilmember Proctor commends Chief Bickerstaff and his department on the recent drug busts in the city.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Bishop and seconded by Council Member Coleman. The vote was unanimous. The meeting ended at 5:12 p.m.
