

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
06-01-2026

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday June 1st, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: David Proctor, Carolyn Smith, Joseph Appleby, Rick Coleman, Larry Bishop. and City Clerk Nicholas New, Police Chief Richard Bickerstaff, Court Clerk Jodie McKinney, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, Ben Burton, and Crystal Maguire from the Clay County Chamber of Commerce.

Mayor Roy Adamson called the meeting to order. Mayor then asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous Council meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member Proctor and seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was made by Council Member Appleby and seconded by Council Member Coleman. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda Crystal Maguire, director of the Clay County Chamber of Commerce, address the Council. Maguire introduced herself as the new director and gave the Council an update on the upcoming chamber events.

Next on the agenda was to accept the resignation of Noah Higgins from the maintenance department effective June 9th, 2026. A motion was made by Councilmember Proctor and seconded by Councilmember Bishop to accept this resignation. The vote was unanimous.

Then on the agenda was to accept the resignation of Christian Fierros from the maintenance department effective June 5th, 2026. A motion was made by Councilmember Coleman and seconded by Councilmember Appleby to accept this resignation. The vote was unanimous.

Next on the agenda was to open two maintenance operator positions and to leave them open until the positions are filled. A motion was made by Councilmember Smith and seconded by Councilmember Appleby to open these positions. The vote was unanimous.

Last on the agenda City Supervisor Taylor recommends that the Council hire Dustin Miles as operator 1 in the maintenance department, subject to a 6-month probationary period. A motion was made by Councilmember Proctor and seconded by Councilmember Bishop to approve this hire. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor Adamson mentions that we will have an America 250 celebration in the City on July 4th.

City Supervisor Taylor mentions that we will host an 8u district tournament starting June 10th, and will host the state softball tournaments for 8u, 10u, and 12u starting June 19th.

Chief Bickerstaff says that the maintenance department installed the poles for the new cameras, and that the cameras will be here in the next 2-3 weeks.

Councilmember Smith gave an update on the upcoming library events and mentioned that Sara Hite was doing a great job as the librarian.

Councilmember Proctor invited the Council to the park on June 5th for the Oldies Under the Stars event starting at 6:00 P.M.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Bishop and seconded by Council Member Coleman. The vote was unanimous. The meeting ended at 5:17 p.m.
